KEYNOTE SPEAKER:

Dr. Randal Henry, DrPH, MPH is the founder and chief intelligence officer of Community Intelligence, LLC, a social justice-oriented research, evaluation and policy consulting firm committed to increasing the capacity of communities, non-profits, foundations, healthcare organizations and government agencies to identify and ameliorate conditions that impact public health, mental health, safety and community well-being.

Prior to founding Community Intelligence, Dr. Henry worked in a variety of public health positions including as an epidemiologist and health planner with the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services; adjunct assistant professor of health policy at the (then) University of Southern California School of Policy, Planning and Development; senior scientist/principal investigator for Children's Hospital Los Angeles; and senior scientist/principal investigator for the U.S. Veterans Health Administration's West Los Angeles Mental Health Outpatient Treatment Center.

Dr. Henry earned his Doctor of Public Health in Health Services Research, Policy and Management and Master of Public Health in Community Health Sciences from the UCLA School of Public Health and his bachelor's degree in political science from California State Polytechnic University, Pomona.
